<b>Giving</b>	<b>Annual Fund</b>	Annual fund helps bridge the gap between tuition fees and the actual cost of attending an independent school. Parent participation is strongly encouraged.

<b>Late Fees</b>	<b>Tuition</b>	If payment is not received within 30 days of the scheduled payment date, per the terms of the enrollment contract, a 2% (two percent) per month interest fee will be imposed.				
	<b>Cafeteria &amp; Other Charges</b>	If payment is not received within 30 days of the monthly accounting family statement, a 2% (two percent) per month interest fee will be imposed.				
<b>Early Bird Discount</b>	\$300 credit for tuition paid-in-full before March 5, 2018.

**(1) Tuition Payment Options:**

- (a) Tuition payment in full with enrollment contract on March 5, 2018 with an early bird discount of \$300.
- (b) Tuition payment in full by May 1, 2018. No additional fees apply.
- (c) Tuition payable in four equal installments due April 15, May 15, June 15, and July 15. Additional \$30 fee per installment.
- (d) Tuition financed through PrimeSouth Bank. Please see business office for details.

Any tuition not paid by the first day of school, other than completed PrimeSouth financing, will accrue interest as outlined under Late Fees.

**(2) Tuition Deposit:** Due with completed enrollment contract (March 5, 2018 for returning families).

**(3) Consumable Fees:** Includes classroom supplies, books and workbooks in Lower School, day-long fieldtrips, Carpe Vitam (additional fee for 8th grade trip), guest speakers, school events, yearbook, student testing (with the exception of AP Exams, ACT and SAT), Graduation. Extra fees may apply for overnight excursions. Consumable fee due on or before September 15, 2018.

**(4) Books & Workbooks:** Required reading novels and workbooks for grades 6th - 12th will be purchased in bulk by school and billed to the student's account. Book fees vary by year.

**(5) Chromebook:** Chromebooks are required for all students in grades 6th - 12th. Please complete the 2018-2019 Chromebook Order Form, also available online at [www.fredericaacademy.org](http://www.fredericaacademy.org) or in the Media Center. Additionally, returning students who already own a Chromebook, should complete the 2018-2019 Chromebook Order Form to decline the Frederica Academy extended warranty, as this fee is auto billed to family accounts.

**(6) Lower & Middle School Uniforms:** Must be purchased through Frederica Academy's approved uniform vendor, Lands' End ([www.landsend.com](http://www.landsend.com)), or the Parent Council sponsored "gently used" uniform sale.

**(7) Cafeteria / Lunch:** Pre-K and Kindergarten students may bring their own lunch or choose the monthly catered option from the cafeteria which is delivered to the classroom. For all other students, cafeteria items are purchased a la carte via cash or charge using a student ID card. Outstanding balances are billed monthly.
