SCHOOL PROFILE

Located on St. Simons Island, Georgia, Frederica Academy is an independent, coeducational, non-sectarian, college preparatory day school, pre-kindergarten through twelfth grade, with an enrollment of approximately 400 students. The school was founded in 1970. ATHLETIC PROFILE

Frederica Academy offers 11 sports, fielding 36 teams at the Middle School, Junior Varsity, and varsity levels. Our teams compete as a member of the Georgia Independent School Association (GISA) in Region 2-AAA. Since 1974, the Frederica Academy Knights have earned 70 State Championships and 155 Region Titles. Approximately 90 percent of our students in grades 6-12 participate in at least one athletic program.

HEAD BASEBALL COACH QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates must have the following minimum qualifications:

- Previous coaching experience at the high school and/or college level with a proven record of success;
- Exceptional knowledge of baseball strategies and philosophy;
- A proven ability to manage a coaching staff and baseball program that includes the Middle School and Varsity baseball teams;
- A skill set and commitment to ensure the maintenance and upkeep of the baseball field and baseball facilities;
- Ability to organize and motivate scholar athletes to achieve maximum performance level in academics as well as athletics;
- A positive passion and enthusiasm for young people with a commitment to fulfilling the school mission; and
- Sound character and personal skills that will attract and retain scholar-athletes.

UPPER SCHOOL HISTORY INSTRUCTOR QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates must have the following minimum qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree required, Master's preferred;
- Ethical behavior, professionalism and a respect for diversity;
- It is preferable that an applicant has multiple years of Upper School teaching experience in an independent school environment;
- Develop the curriculum materials, syllabus, outlines and assessments;
- Conduct after-school tutorial as scheduled;
- Participate in all advisory, faculty and department meetings as called;
- Be involved in the life of the school, beyond the classroom (coaching and/or advisor to an organization of student leadership); and
- Fulfill additional duties as assigned by the Upper School Director or Head of School.

In addition to the minimum qualifications, a strong candidate will demonstrate an ability to promote Frederica Academy and its athletic program in the community through strong communication and interpersonal skills. Experience in a reputable independent school would be beneficial. Of importance is the ability to live and work well in our small coastal community.
