Frederica Academy is an independent, coeducational, non-sectarian, college preparatory day school with an enrollment of approximately 450 students in pre-kindergarten through twelfth grade. The school was founded in 1969 and is governed by an Honor Code.

ONLINE COURSES

Online courses through Fuel Education/K12 and Georgia Virtual School are offered for enrichment, credit recovery, and schedule conflicts. Students may enroll in an online class during the academic school year or summer with Upper School Administration’s approval. Courses taken through each program will be indicated on Frederica Academy’s transcript.

DUAL ENROLLMENT

Frederica Academy participates in the Dual Enrollment program with the College of Coastal Georgia. Juniors are permitted to enroll in one elective course each semester. Seniors are permitted to enroll in two elective courses each semester. Courses must be approved by the college’s Dual Enrollment program and Frederica Academy’s College Counseling Office. Grades received in Dual Enrollment courses will count toward a student’s cumulative high school GPA, but will not be included in a student’s cumulative numeric average. Courses will be given a 0.5 weight when calculating the GPA on Frederica Academy’s transcript.

ACADEMIC HONORS

The Head of School List and the Honor Roll are calculated on a semester basis. The Head of School List recognizes students whose weighted grades in academic classes are 90 and above. The Honor Roll recognizes students whose weighted grades in academic classes are 80 and above. To graduate

with Honors, an Upper School student must have a minimum cumulative numerical average of 90.

HONORS COURSES

Students are given the option to enroll in Honors level courses for the following classes: Biology, Chemistry, English 10, Computer Science Electives. Students taking the following courses at an advanced grade level are placed in Honors sections: Geometry, Algebra II, PreCalculus, Latin/Spanish II, Latin/Spanish III, Latin/ Spanish IV. In the event of a scheduling conflict, students may be placed in alternative courses.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT

To enroll in an Advanced Placement (AP) course, students must receive departmental approval and must be in good academic standing. Only seniors are exempt from taking AP Exams. For the 2021-2022 school year, 81 students took one or more AP exams, for a total of 168 exams. 74% of students scored at least a 3 or higher on one or more AP exams. 18 students received the distinction of AP Scholar, 7 AP Scholar with Honors, and 7 AP Scholar with Distinction.
