Job Summary:

Frederica Academy seeks an Upper School Science Instructor, a 10-month faculty position, to begin in August 2022. Interested applicants should be able to teach one of more of the following: Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and/or related AP science disciplines.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

- Develop the curriculum materials, syllabus, outlines and assessments.
- Conduct after-school tutorial as scheduled
- Be involved in the life of the school, beyond the classroom (coaching and/or advisory to an organization of student leadership)
- Participate in all advisory, faculty and department meetings as called
- Complete required Human Resources trainings each year (CPR, first aid, mandatory reporting, etc.)
- Fulfill additional duties as assigned by the Upper School Director or Head of School

Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree in a Science discipline. Master's degree is preferred.
- A strong desire to work in a collaborative community.
- Demonstrates flexibility and responsiveness to a variety of learning styles and a range of abilities.
- Ethical behavior, professionalism and a respect for diversity.
- Preferable to have multiple years of Upper School experience in an independent school atmosphere.
- Strong instructional and classroom management skills.
- Energy, empathy, flexibility, and collaboration.
- Good organizational and communication skills.
